



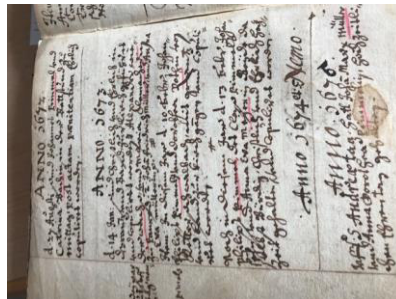
Research August 2019 in Ketternschwalbach and Panrod for Hans Wiederwachs, born 1625

What did we know?

His son (Alexander) and grandson (Johan Heinrich Cristophel) appear to have lived in Ketternschwalbach, Briehardt, and Panrod. In 1707-1710, Johan Heinrich Cristophel traveled to Hoog, then England, then on to New York.

What did we find?

By the help of two local researchers from the area we found original records of church documents and invoices, partly dating back to 1630



What else?

The two researchers Mr. Alberti and Mr. Wukash took us along the little towns, into the church, into the very old steep and high wooden church tower and had prepared copies of the records for our visitors to take back home. They also received a book from the area as a present.

What had impressed us most?

On the fly leaf of the original there appeared the following:
In the year after the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, 1723
January 14th have I, in my quality of extraordinary instructor (first) dedicated
the Church or the Lord's house, in the flourishing high Dutch
congregation of the Camp. The dedication-text was taken from
the Prophecy of Esaias Ch. 26 vs 2: "Open the gates that the faithful
people, observing the covenants, may enter." In the afternoon from Paul's
Epistle to the Ephesians Chap. VI vs. 23: "Peace be unto the brethren" etc
and 24: "Grace be with all those loving our Lord J. C." etc. Amen
The above was in Dutch and entered by Rev. Johannes van
Wriessen, stated pastor at the Kinderhook and Claverack.
